Stan and I were at a car show at the Dairy Queen in Franklin one beautiful day in 2003 and we saw this beautiful Plymouth with 2 VERY TALL (at least to me) people sitting in lawn chairs behind it. 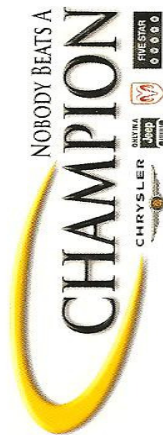

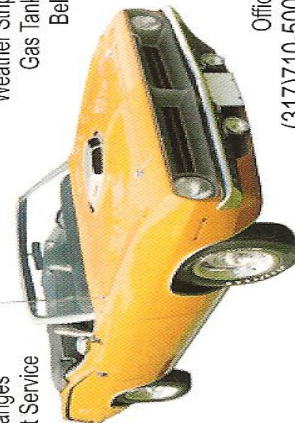
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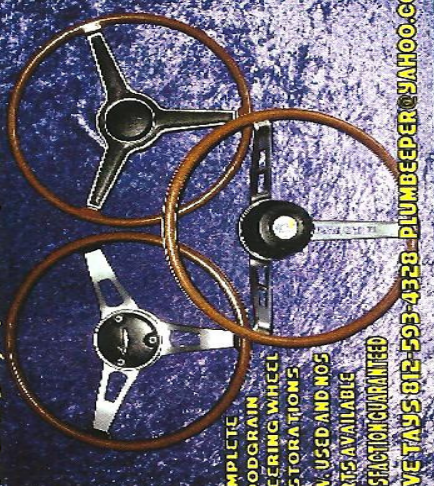
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
