Something different this month for the profile. I've done profiles on the cars so this month we are gonna show where they live.

The truth is, they live in a larger home than I do. Started building the garage in the spring of '08 and completed it the winter of the same year. It finished out around 1250 square feet. It is 36 feet across the front then goes back 48 feet on the left side. It then goes to the right 16 feet and then 24 feet back up toward the front. From here it goes 20 feet to the right, then 24 feet to the front. It is in the shape of an "L". Had to build it this way to clear the septic system.



It has two 45,000 btu furnaces and a 27,000 btu air conditioner. I keep it 55 degrees in the winter. I bump it up to 70 if we are having folks over for Thanksgiving or Christmas. It's a great place for that.

The walls have R19 and the ceiling is R30. There is a large wash basin and a floor drain in the car wash area. The ceiling is 12' 6" to clear the two lifts.

The lifts are probably the best things in the garage. They are very handy. Great for detailing the cars...just raise 'um up where you need them.

I still need to get the Route 66 and The Hot Rod Power Tour walls finished. I have more stuff to put up. I also have a 6' x 12' Stars and Stripes flag to put on the ceiling. James Watson gave it to me. He was a Nave Seal and was a plank owner of Seal Team Two.



I spend a lot of time in the garage reading old Hot Rod mags and listening to Marl Shop Oldies. Takes me back to the 60's....a time I really enjoyed.



My garage is open to anyone that might need to use one of the lifts. Just give me a yell and I'll try to make a space for you. I really love the finished product. I think the cars like it too.
