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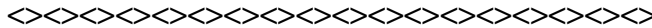
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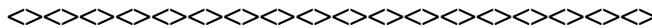
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Meetings are the last Thursday of every month except November & December.

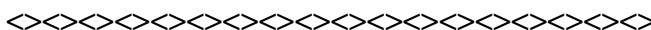
